



Learning Circle Preschool Summer Arts and Science Outline of the Day

- 8:30 – 9:00 Children wash hands with family before coming into the classroom. After signing in, children have opportunities to play indoors. Children who choose may help prepare the day's snack
- 9:00 – 9:20 Meeting is held as a whole group in the welcome room, and may include singing, circle games, whole group reading, or conversation. At the end of meeting, teachers present information and/or materials relating to daily focused activities
- 9:20 – 10:10 Small group opportunities with teachers and materials are available with a focus and theme each day. Children rotate through these experiences at their own pace, as teachers facilitate
- 10:10 – 10:30 Snack processes begin as children are ready. After hand washing, children help set up snack outdoors (weather permitting)
- 10:30 – 11:30 Outdoor activities (weather permitting) include active play, blocks and construction, painting and drawing, science investigation and observation, reading, sand play, and other experiences planned daily that relate to group projects and themes
- 11:30 – 11:45 Cleanup begins
- 11:45 – 12:10 After washing up and setting the table, children and teachers enjoy lunch together
- 12:10 – 12:25 As children finish lunch and clean up, they participate in a brief quiet book time, relaxing with a book.
- 12:25 – 12:30 Children sing goodbye and wait in the classroom meeting area for their "important person" to pick them up

**Please note that toileting occurs throughout the day as needed
